Project Overview

We were delighted to be appointed by main contractors Bowmer & Kirkland to deliver the glazing and curtain walling aspects of the new Leonardo Hotel, Manchester.

The new hotel is located close to the developer's Crusader Mill residential scheme, and London Warehouse, a multi-million-pound refurbishment of the former Place aparthotel.

The 13-storey hotel accommodates 275 bedrooms, meeting rooms, a large ground floor restaurant and back of house areas. The façade features a number of projecting planters in an attempt to green the city.

The striking design, nicknamed the 'Jenga Hotel' by locals, has transformed the Manchester skyline attaining iconic status as one of the city's most unusual buildings.


